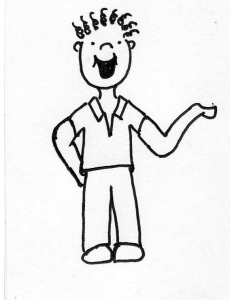


# Mary and Joseph travel to Bethlehem and Jesus is born!
