Gift Aid: To take advantage of the Gift Aid Scheme you must be a UK taxpayer and pay sufficient income tax (at whatever rate) or capital gains tax in each year to cover the tax reclaimed on your giving (currently 28p for every £1 you give). All you have to do is tell us that you want your donation to be treated as a Gift Aid donation. This one-off declaration can cover all donations that you make to BRF in future as well.

Notes:

1. Please advise BRF if you change your name or address while your declaration is still in force. You can cancel the declaration at any time by notifying BRF. It will then not apply to donations you make on or after the date of cancellations or such later date as you specify.
2. If in the future your circumstances change and you cease to be a tax payer or pay enough tax you can advise BRF to cancel your declaration (see note 1).
3. If you pay tax at the higher rate you can claim further tax relief in your Self Assessment tax return.
