



Legitimate use of purchasable downloadable media

Downloadable media purchased from The Bible Reading Fellowship, including (but not limited to) mp3 music and PDF document downloads, is protected by UK and international copyright laws and is intended for personal use only. In addition, content within any downloadable media (including cover images where applicable) are protected by Copyright. Thus, changing content or format, printing of documents, distributing, lending or copying of such media is illegal, **except** in the following situations:

- Printing a single copy of a PDF document for personal use only is permitted.
- Specific downloadable titles in PDF format may have certain pages labelled as '*Reproduced with permission from...*' at the bottom of the page. Pages labelled in this way may be printed without limit (for example, for performance purposes) as permission has already been granted for these.
- Printing of multiple copies of musical scores within PDF documents is not permitted except where the organisation printing them has appropriate licences. See <http://www.ccli.co.uk> for more information.
- Burning mp3 audio files to a single CD for use in venues where mp3s cannot be played is permitted.
- We permit customers to retain a single backup copy of any electronic media purchased from The Bible Reading Fellowship (provided only one copy is in use at any one time).
