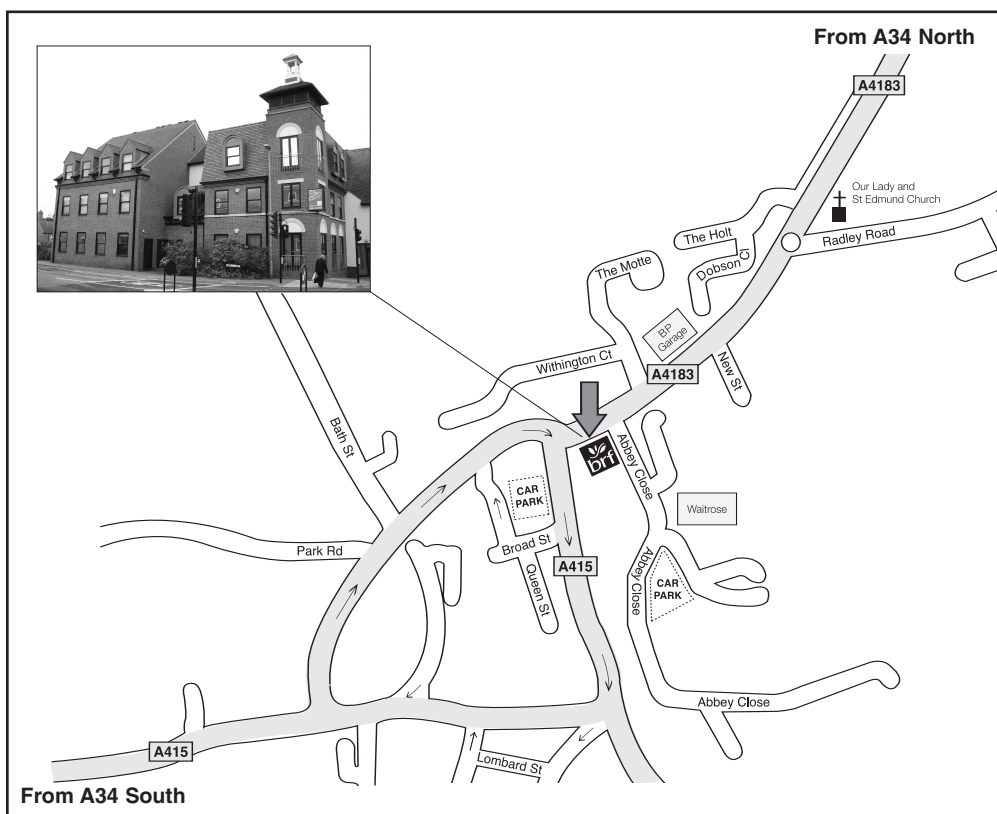


HOW TO FIND BRF

Physical address is locally known as 15 Vineyard, Abingdon, if asking for directions.

The BRF office is situated in Abingdon, seven miles south of Oxford; it is on the corner of Vineyard and Abbey Close.

If you use a downloadable map or a satellite navigation system, please note that our postcode may not be recognized. We have applied to Royal Mail for a unique postcode but this takes time to populate websites. If you want to locate us by postcode, we suggest you use OX14 3PX.

By Public Transport

Abingdon can be accessed from Central Oxford by the X3 or X13 buses. These run approximately every 10 minutes during the day, and every 15 minutes in the evening.

From Oxford Railway Station, leave the station by the main exit. The X3 departs from Stop R3, which is immediately to the left upon exiting the station.

From Central Oxford, walk to St Aldates and catch the X3 or X13 at stand H3 (opposite the Main Oxford Post Office).

As you approach Abingdon town centre, the bus will pass Our Lady and St Edmund Catholic Church on the left-hand side, just before a mini-roundabout. Alight at the next stop, just before a BP petrol station on the right-hand side of the road. Walk in the same direction of travel and, at the junction, turn left into Abbey Close. The office is on the right.

By Car

Parking can be found in a large multi-storey car park in Stert Street (directions below). If your meeting is going to be longer than 2 hours, use the upper floors where you can park for longer. There is also limited parking available outside the office on Abbey Close.

From the North (Oxford/M40 from Birmingham) – Travel southbound on the A34 towards Abingdon and take the exit signposted Abingdon North. Turn left at the top of the slip road towards Abingdon. At the roundabout, take the second exit, signed Abingdon Town Centre. Shortly after Our Lady and St Edmund Catholic Church (on the left-hand side), take the second exit at a mini-roundabout. Pass the BP petrol station on the right. At the traffic lights, if proceeding directly to the office, turn left (signed Supermarket, Council Offices, Guildhall), and the office is a few metres along on the right-hand side. For parking, turn left into Abbey Close in the direction of the Guildhall (for short term pay & display parking) or carry on straight ahead at the lights, turn left into the one-way system, and take the next right turn into the multi-storey car park.

From the South (M40 from London) – M40 to Oxford, follow signs for Ring Road, Newbury and A34 Southbound. Then follow instructions as above. NB: There is a cross-country route from junction 7 of the M40 but at peak times this can be congested.

From the South (M4, A34 northbound) – Exit the A34 at Abingdon South. At the roundabout, take the third exit, signed Abingdon. Go straight over two roundabouts, then straight across a double mini-roundabout, following signs for Town Centre. The road bears left. Carry straight on through a set of traffic lights. At the next set of lights, if proceeding directly to the office, turn left into Vineyard and then right into Abbey Close (signed Supermarket, Council Offices, Guildhall). For parking, turn right from Stratton Way into Stert Street, and then turn right into the multi-storey car park.
