

In this extensively updated second edition of *A Christian Guide to Environmental Issues*, Martin and Margot Hodson consider eight key environmental issues in light

of the major changes and developments that have taken place since the book first appeared in 2015. Covering biodiversity, climate change, water, energy, soil, food, population and consumption and environment and sustainable development, the theological reflections remain similar but the issues section has been extensively rewritten to reflect the rising and widening concern for the environment within the church. President Biden's invitation to 40 world leaders to an historic online environment summit, beginning on 22 April, is indicative of the scale of change in recent years.

Our growing awareness of the environmental crisis we face leaves many people feeling overwhelmed and paralysed. But challenging though the situation is, there is still hope, and often what people need is the confidence to know where to start.
