- 2. Why do you think Xerxes wanted Vashti to come to his banquet?
- 3. Queen Vashti bravely refused to be paraded in front of King Xerxes' guests. Why might she have done this? What might a modern-day equivalent of this be?
- 4. Brené Brown writes:

Shame is the most powerful master emotion. It's the fear that we're not good enough.

What role does shame play in this text?

- 5. There is a section in *Unveiled* titled #ThemToo. What are your thoughts about the #MeToo movement? Has it made a difference to women's experiences of sexual harassment?
