

BRF is delighted to congratulate Jamie Hawker, aged 15, who has been honoured with <u>The Diana Award</u> for going above and beyond in his daily life to create and sustain positive change. Jamie co-authored *Changing the Climate: Applying the Bible in a climate emergency* (BRF, 2021) with his parents, Debbie and David Hawker.

Established in memory of Diana, Princess of Wales, the award is given out by the charity of the same name and has the support of both her sons, The Duke of Cambridge and The Duke of Sussex. The Diana Award is the highest accolade a young person can achieve for social action or humanitarian efforts.

Changemakers for a generation

Jamie was nominated for his environmental activities. Written during the first lockdown in 2020, the aim of *Changing the Climate* is to encourage people to take action on climate justice. It includes over 130 tips from Jamie on how to care for creation.

Jamie has given talks about plastic waste and climate change in his community, and he has been interviewed in churches and online. He personally does what he can to reduce his carbon emissions.

'We warmly congratulate our new Diana Award recipients from the UK and across the world who are changemakers for their generation. It is especially poignant as we remember Princess Diana 25 years on.
