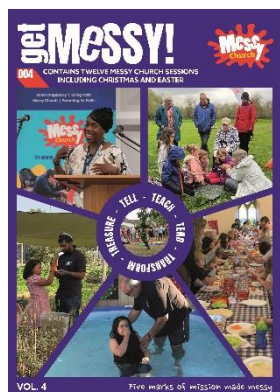

Each volume of *Get Messy!* contains twelve session outlines for Messy Churches, running through the year from September to August. Everything you need to run your Messy Church is here, including activity photos, mealtime cards, social action ideas and templates. Additional support material is downloadable from the Messy Church website. The theme of this issue is 'Five marks of mission made messy' and session material on the five marks – tell, teach, tend, transform, and treasure – is written by contributors from around the country and beyond, including New Zealand and Australia. Topics include God's mission, getting the news out, how we treat others, social justice, stewardship of nature and treasures in heaven. An essential magazine for Messy Church team leaders and helpers, *Get Messy!* is also invaluable for people who run café-style churches, and church leaders looking for all-age material and ideas.
